The next objective of the program will be to increase the income of the families from the villages where we had worked for Infrastructural development i.e. Water, Internal Roads, Health & Education.

The initiatives like Skill Development, Sanitation of Schools and Swachh Bharat and Digital India are part of national vision for social development. We have participated in Swachha Bharat by constructing toilets in government schools, by launching vermicomposting project and by starting skill development projects. In Skill Development Bharat Forge has taken up leading role by establishing ITI at Khed by starting vocational courses & by adopting 2 more ITIs at Malegaon & Bhor. Bharat Forge had also imparted training programme "Technical Educator's Reinvention Course" (TERC) to 241 ITI Instructors from Pune District. The objective was to equip the instructors with important tools to perform their role as accomplished instructor. "Changing Gears"- Finishing School programme is an initiative of BFL in collaboration with CII for 90 Graduate Engineers from rural background from College of Engineering Pune. The objective is to develop the required soft skills for their employability. The Kalyani School and our educational projects are achieving further milestones.

After the launch of CSR projects, now it is time to think seriously about the outcomes and impact of these projects.

We sincerely feel that the role of Corporates is not just funding the CSR project but to participate in the process of social development with project management skills, technology and by involving stakeholders of the business. Bharat Forge understands that 'Inclusive growth' i.e. taking participation of all the sectors of the society in the socio economic development process of this country, is the spirit behind the CSR Act.

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











HEALTH CHECK UP

This would help them meet their individual needs as well as help them develop an additional source of income.













Currently, Pradnya Vikas projects are carried out at Janata Vasahat (Parvati), Malvadi (Hadapsar) & Keshav Nagar (Mundhwa). Their weekly activities include prayers, poems, story

writing activity, yoga & physical exercises, newspaper reading, learning to use internet, making PowerPoint presentations, etc.

KHELGHAR

The company has developed 'Khelghars' for children living in slum areas whose parents go to work early morning and come back late evening. They are centres that aims to develop basic skills, creativity, awareness on health and personal grooming of the children. Currently we have 3 Khelghars: 2 at Keshavnagar and 1 at hadapsar with 120 kids enrolled. The children are selected after studying the socio economic background of the



children and having a pre test for them. The test checks their ability in subjects like Marathi, Math and life skills. Students who are lagging and in need of support are selected for khelghar.
