

We at Bharat Forge Ltd. strongly believe that the spirit behind CSR Act of 2013 is inclusive growth. Every last person in the village has to be included in the growth process of our nation. Along with Skill Development, Education & Community Development projects we decided to initiate a Rural Development project by starting work in 3 villages near Pune.

After getting insight into the processes & methodology by understanding human engineering and connect, we started working in more villages. The indicators of development were water, internal roads, livelihood, education and health. Our projects were completed in 10 villages by following all the processes like baseline surveys, meeting with villagers to understand their core needs, and designing of project to address the needs. Our Chairman had set the vision of developing 100 villages from Maharashtra. Today at any given time we simultaneously work on 20 to 25 civil projects for water and internal roads, and about 10 to 15 projects in the area of health and education. The implementation of all these projects has helped to increase the income level of the villagers and improved their quality of life.

We never claim that we adopt a village, we always try to become catalyst in the processes of development and hand it over to the villagers to take it ahead. This ensures sustainability of the projects.



In Satara we experienced that our small efforts in 29 villages have stimulated a driving force in the villages and the local governance to take the development process ahead as a movement. We also witnessed the magic of selfless work by the villagers who worked together despite of their political, economical & social differences.

Our nation requires such "movements" for the development of common people, which in turn, leads to the development of our country.

This development program runs multiple projects focusing on various domains such as,







To address the much-needed primary healthcare in remote regions which had very erratic to no access to medical infrastructure and resources, Bharat Forge set up five software-enabled telemedicine clinics. Skill development hones the potential of eradicating widespread employment.

With this view, Bharat Forge has partnered with 4 Industrial Training Institutes (ITI) to run skill development programmes for the youth of various underprivileged communities.

This programme equips individuals, primarily rural youth, with various vocational skills which enhances their employability.

Cumulatively, this programme has imparted careeraltering skills to over three thousand students.



COURSE COMPLETION OF SECOND BATCH- RF AND MICROWAVE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM AT KCTI-PUNE

Bharat forge limited in 2020 has started the second batch for specialist course of "Radio Frequency and Microwave Technology" for engineering Graduates and post-graduate students. BFL has signed an MoU with SGGSIET Nanded. with the Aim to impart specialized skills in Signal Processing and Embedded System and an objective of promoting employment and enhancing vocational skills of engineering students. Also, this initiative has embarked upon one mission to bridge the gap between industry and institution.

14 trainee engineers have successfully completed the training program during year 2020-21 and got the job opportunities in other companies. The certificate distribution ceremony for second batch of RF Training program was held on 11th Sept 2021 at KCTI-Pune. Certificate were handed over to all the trainees by Dr Rajkumar Singh, Dr Leena Deshpande, Dr Y V Joshi and Dr Manesh Kokare in presence of other dignitaries from Defence R&D-KCTI.





Bharat Forge has collaborated with Vidya Pratishthan, Baramati for setting up the Centre of Excellence Lab for providing skill training in the area of Artificial Intelligence, IoT, Machine learning, etc. with the objective to impart the new age technological skills to the rural youth. the program also aims at maximum participation from girl students to ensure women empowerment and employability enhancement.





SUCCESS STORIES

ANALYSIS OF THE PROBLEM -

The villages of Satara District have been affected by drought for the last 15 years. Agriculture was primarily rain-fed & for the remaining six months, the village was heavily dependent on a water body located 5 km away. Most villagers migrated to cities in search of livelihoods.

DRIVING TOWARDS A SOLUTION -

With inputs from Bharat Forge, the water body was de-silted. This had multiple benefits. There was a marked increase in water levels of the village's wells. The silt removed from the water body was then laid on the rocky fields turning them into fertile lands. Availability of water coupled with fertile silt led to an increase in irrigated land area, encouraged the production of cash crops like ginger, improved crop productivity & reduced the costs of fertilizers. This led to a guaranteed and systematic increase in the villagers' income, helping them sustain for the next seven to eight years. This also reduced up to 10% in migration of the local population. The village now grows 25000 tons of sugarcane. This growth is substantial and exponential as they started without a single sugarcane plant and are now exporting it. This has helped to increase their income level by more than 6% and has helped in improving their quality of life.





ANALYSIS OF THE PROBLEM -

Mandanwadi in Baramati depended heavily on government water tankers for their needs. Acute water shortage affected their ability to undertake Agriculture throughout the year.

DRIVING TOWARDS A SOLUTION -

Bharat Forge undertook the colossal task of widening & deepening a nearby lake, effectively increasing the 3,00,000 CuM water storage capacity. The lake today irrigates 546 hectares of agricultural land, benefitting more than 1000 farmers from four neighboring villages apart from Madanwadi itself. The silt was utilized for the construction of 2.5 km of internal roads. All the nearby wells are filled, and the village has completely lost its water tankers completely.

ANALYSIS OF THE PROBLEM -

Kalewadi is a drought-prone area from Purandar Taluka facing a drinking water crisis. Agriculture faced difficulties due to the same. Dependence on water tankers created a hostile and uncertain situation for the villagers.

DRIVING TOWARDS A SOLUTION -

The water was arranged to the doorstep through a pipeline under the Purandar Upasa Sinchan scheme. Water is now available to them throughout the year. Changes in the cropping pattern resulted in better yield and financial capability. The farmers have started processing units of fruits. The tree plantation along the roads' sides changed the village's face. After encouraging a self-sustained livelihood, BFL could extract their dependency from the village.
