Water Harvesting Project at village Hivare

Desilting & repairing of bandhara at Hivare village

- Measurement : 24.50 Mtrs length*3.5 Mtrs height *1 Mtrs top length
- Water storage capacity :11.00 TCM
- 150 hectors of land will come under irrigation and it will benefit 4,200 villagers.



Repairing & desilting of bandhara at Village Hivare will store 11TCM of water which will be useful for drinking and agriculture Purpose .

Taluka: Koregaon District: Satara

Water Harvesting Project at village Belewadi

Desilting of bandhara at Belewadi village

- Measurement : 30,000 Cubic Meter silt removed.
- Water storage capacity : 30.00 TCM by which 200 hectors of land will come under irrigation.
- This work will benefit to 3,100 villagers



Desilting of water reservoir at Village Belewadi will make water available for drinking and agriculture purpose.

Water Harvesting Project at village Chilewadi 'Work in progress'

Desilting of bandhara at Chilewadi village

- Measurement : 37,000 cubic meter silt removed.
- Water storage capacity : 37.00 TCM and 250 hectors of land will come under irrigation
- This work will benefit to 2,100 villagers



Desilting of water reservoir at Village Chilewadi will store 37 TCM of water which will be utilized for agriculture and drinking purpose.

Taluka: Purandar District: Pune



Water Harvesting Project at village Kodit (Work in progress)

Desilting of bandhara at Kodit village

- Measurement : 17,000 cubic meter silt is to be removed.
- Water storage capacity :17.00 TCM and 120 hectors of land will come under irrigation.
- This work will benefit to 1,900 villagers.



Repairing of bandhara at Village Kodit will store 17 TCM of water which will be useful for drinking and agriculture Purpose. Desilting of 2 different bandharas at Village Kodit will increase the water storage capacity of bandhara. After this work the drought hit village will be having water availability for drinking and agriculture purpose.

Taluka: Purandar District: Pune

Water Harvesting work at village Chambali (Work in progress)

Desilting of bandhara at Chambali village

- Measurement : 33000 cubic meter silt removed.
- Water storage capacity : 33.00 TCM and 220 hectares of land will come under irrigation.
- This work will benefit to 4,000 villagers.



Chambali is a drought hit village. Currently there is no water storage provision and the existing water reservoir is not in a good condition. The desilting work will make water available after rainy season .

Project - Village Development



Taluka: Purandar District: Pune

Water Harvesting work at village Patharwadi [Bhivari] (Work in progress)

Desilting of bandhara at Patharwadi village

- Measurement : 23,000 cubic meter silt is to be removed.
- Water storage capacity : 23.00 TCM and 190 hectares of land will come under irrigation
- This work will benefit to 1,500 villagers.



This region in Purandar taluka has very low rainfall and this water conservation work will help the people to access the water for agriculture and drinking purpose.



Taluka: Ambegaon District: Pune

Water Harvesting work at village Thakarwadi (Work in progress)

Desilting of bandhara at Thakarwadi village

- Measurement: 16,000 Cubic Meter silt removed.
- Water storage capacity :16.00 TCM and 80 hectors of land will come under irrigation
- This work will benefit 3,400 villagers



Due to this deepening work of the bandhara, 16 TCM water storage capacity will be created and the water scarcity problem for drinking and agriculture will be solved.

Project - Village Development

Taluka: Shevgaon District: Ahmednagar

Water Harvesting work at village Wagholi (Work in progress)

Desilting of Vruddha river in Wagholi village

- Measurement: 75,000 Cubic Meter of silt is to be removed.
- Water storage capacity: 75.00 TCM and 350 hectares of land will come under irrigation.

Taluka: Shevgaon District: Ahmednagar

Water Harvesting work at village Phalakewadi (Work in progress)

Desilting of bandhara at Phalakewadi village

- Measurement : 60,000 cubic meter silt is to be removed.
- Water storage capacity : 60.00 TCM and 300 hecters of land will come under irrigation.



Desilting of Vruddha river at Village Wagholi & Phalakewadi will make water available for drinking and agricultural. The drought hit village will now get converted into Green Village.

Construction of underground gutters at village Kole

- We are constructing the underground gutters at village Kole.
- This work will help to maintain the cleanliness & environmental hygiene in the village.
- It will also help to make wider roads.
- This work will benefit 5,200 villagers in terms of quality of life and improved health status.
