

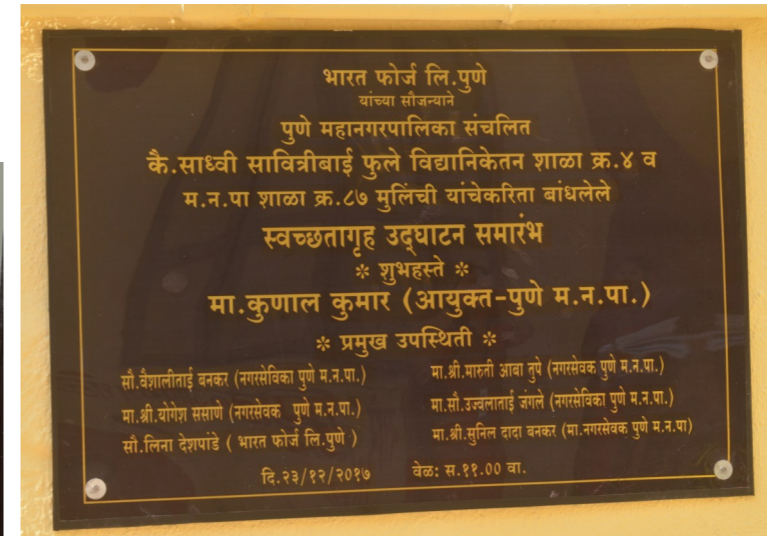
# SCHOOL ADOPTION
