Project - ‘Udan’

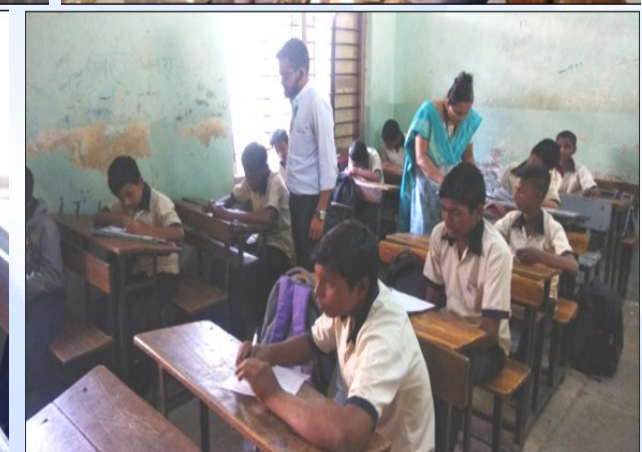

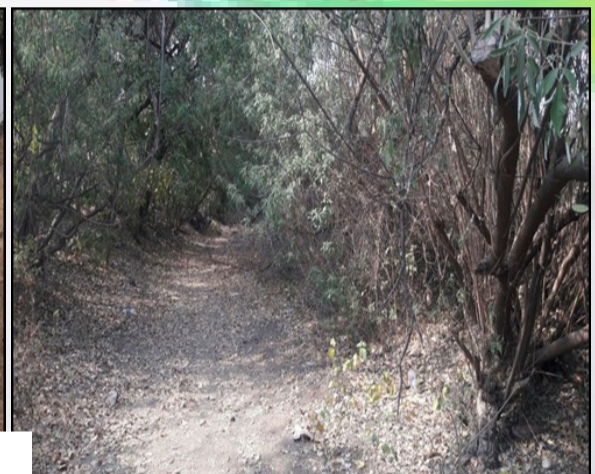

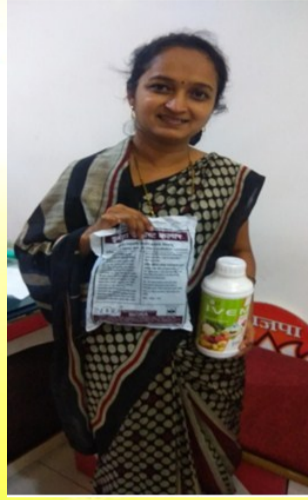
