भारत फोर्जने भागवली भोजनेवाडीकरांची तहान ग्रामस्थांनी साजरा केला आनंद : महिलांच्या डोक्यावरील हंडा उतरणार

शिन्वोली, दि. १८ (प्रतिनिधी) - आंबेगाव तालुक्याच्या पश्चिम आदिवासी भागामध्ये डोंगराच्या कुशीत उगलेवाडी वसलेले आहे. सुमारे १७३ लोकवस्ती असलेल्या या गावातील भोजनेवाडीला भारत फोर्ज कंपनी पुणे व महाराष्ट्र आरोग्य मंडळ पुणे यांच्या प्रयत्नांमुळे प्रथमच नळाद्वारे पाणी मिळाल्याने वाडीतील ग्रामस्थांनी आनंद साजरा केला.

भोजनेवाडी ही वस्ती घोडनदीपासून ७ किमी दूर व १२५० फूट उंचीवर वसलेली आहे. येथे वाडीच्या वरच्या बाजूस असलेल्या शिवकालीन टाकीमधील पाण्यावरच या वस्तीची गुजारण होत असते. मात्र, वर्षभर या वाडीतील ग्रामस्थ आणि महिलांना दररोज एक ते दीड किलोमीटर अंतर पायी चालून डोक्यावर पाणी आणावे

लागत होते. याबाबत येथील ग्रामस्थांनी व ग्रामपंचायतीने महाराष्ट्र आरोग्य मंडळ यांच्याकडे कैफियत मांडल्यानंतर संस्था कार्यकर्ते व भारत फोर्ज कंपनीच्या अधिकाऱ्यांनी प्रत्यक्ष वाडीला भेट दिली. या ठिकाणी पाण्याची कशी व्यवस्था करता येईल याची पहानी केली. तज्ज्ञांकडून जीपीएसद्वारे सर्व्हे करून वाडीच्या वरच्या बाजूस असलेल्या शिवकालीन टाकीतून सायफन पद्धतीने पाणी वाडीत नेऊन तेथे साठवण टाकी बांधून नळाद्वारे पाणी पुरवठा योजना तयार केली. त्यासाठी आवश्यक असणारा निधी भारत फोर्ज कंपनी पुणे यांनी तसेच तांत्रिक मार्गदर्शन महाराष्ट्र आरोग्य मंडळाने देण्याची दाखवली. त्यानुसार ग्रामपंचायत आणि ग्रामस्थांच्या सहकार्याने ही योजना पूर्ण केली. सावजनिक ठिकाणी नळ कनेक्शन काढून ग्रामस्थांचा पाण्याचा

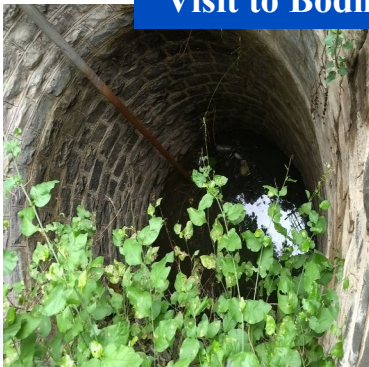

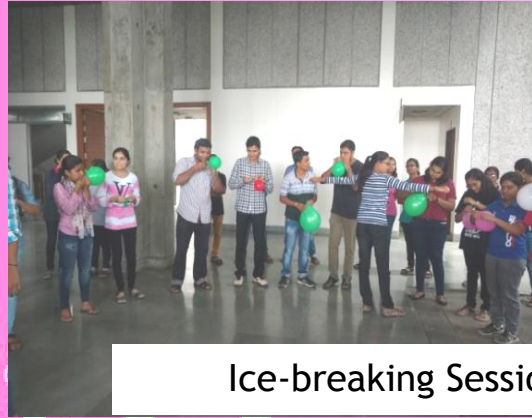
Finishing School Programme

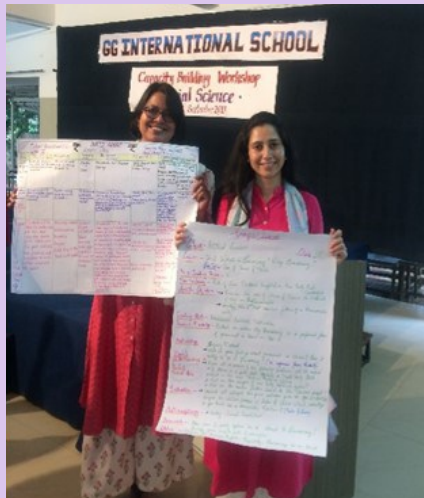
Teachers' Day Celebration
