- Overall 17 schools from Koregaon & Khatav taluka have been covered under this initiative where 1KW capacity of solar panels are installed on the roof of ZP schools.
- The Zillah Parishad school faced financial difficulties in paying its electricity bill, leading to significant arrears. By this initiative the burden of the light bills will be minimized and money saved will be utilized for other developmental work.

Installation of rooftop solar system at Chetana Apangmati Vikas Sanstha ,Kolhapur.

- Work Details: 12 KW capacity of solar panels are installed.
- Overall 200 students are going to be benefitted.
- About Organization: It is an NGO working in Kolhapur for the Education and Rehabilitation
 of the Intellectually Challenged Children. The school is run for these children who are in the
 age group of 6 to 18 yrs. They are also running vocational training Centre for the children
 above 18 years. More than 200 students are getting benefited from this initiative.



Installation of solar units will save the expenses on electricity which can be used for other developmental work of the organization.
